



Discover the charms of Sri Lanka with Amari Galle



Welcome to Galle, a world within a world steeped in culture and history. Shrouded in legend and mystery, Galle is one of the most important cities on the south coast of Sri Lanka. Once the main port of the island, Galle channelled a flourishing trade in luxury commodities such as metals, precious stones, ivory, livestock and spices. Since the island's colonisation by the Portuguese, the Dutch and the British, the city has been an integral part of Sri Lanka's modern history.

A living, breathing city of significant historical value, Galle greets visitors as the gateway to the south. Even through the rolling streams of time and change, Galle continues to preserve an atmosphere of the past, which is apparent in its most prominent feature and oldest landmark, Galle Fort, which was built by the Dutch more than 500 years ago and is currently an archaeological reserve that has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Nestled on the golden sandy crescent on the south coast, only 10 minutes away from the magnificent Galle Fort is Amari Galle, Sri Lanka's very first Amari hotel. The hotel is located along the main Colombo-Galle Road with a travel time of two and a half hours from Sri Lanka's international airport in Colombo.

Amari Galle's architecture and design is inspired by the natural beauty of the Galle coastline. A panoramic view of the ocean, the gentle sea breeze and the warm southern smiles of the Amari Galle team greet guests upon their arrival. The lobby is inspired by the city's natural resources, a reference to its rich and unique past. Within this serene atmosphere, guests are welcomed by two signature sculptures that pay tribute to the beautiful coastline of Galle. A large, magnificent fixture resembling corals adorns one wall whilst another reminiscent of beach parasols adorns the opposite wall.

Vertical fins with wood finishing, marble floors and a subtle punch of colour stand side by side illuminated by soft lighting. Amari Galle consists of unique spaces designed with the elements of nature, refreshing the weary traveller and preparing them for a journey of fun and relaxation.

The essence of Galle is further captured through the hotel's beautifully appointed rooms and suites, all of which are fully equipped with modern amenities and private balconies overlooking the Indian Ocean. Each of the 172 guestrooms and suites features spacious and light-filled interiors that capture the tranquillity of the coastline





with soothing colour schemes to create a beach house feel. Rooms feature artwork that reflects the common sights of the location.

Amari Galle is also home to a 360-square-metre presidential suite, which was inspired by the concept of 'day meets night' with merging colour tones depicting the magical hues of dusk. Commanding a breath-taking view from the top floor, this two-bedroom suite includes a dining area, a living room and a balcony terrace with a private plunge pool.

Make a pit stop at Voyager Lounge

Located on the lobby level, Voyager Lounge is a warm and friendly space designed for informal gatherings. This 24-hour facility is equipped with luggage-sized lockers and shower facilities, making it an ideal relaxation space for early arrivals or late departures. Inspired by the clouds that appear over the Galle horizon, the design of the lounge instils a homely sense of calmness with its comfortable seating, TV, free Wi-Fi, workstations and library. While relaxing in this cosy setting, guests may also enjoy a range of freshly baked items, sandwiches and cakes, together with a diverse selection of coffee and Ceylon tea.

A culinary journey at Ahara Gourmet Gallery

Inspired by the rich street food culture of the region, Ahara Gourmet Gallery is the signature market-style restaurant of Amari Galle where the feeling of togetherness merges with food and culture in an energetic setting. Live kitchens offer guests the opportunity to interact with the chefs and experience the vibrant flavours of Asian and international cuisines. The exquisite menu consists of a wide selection of sharing dishes, because at Amari, experiences are better when enjoyed together. Ahara Gourmet Gallery is located on the garden level and is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
